

RUNMAGEDDON/ GLADIATOR RACE RULEBOOK

I. PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

1. This document sets set out the rules for participation in sporting events organized by Extreme Events Sp. z o.o. with its seat in Warsaw and the Sportvisio z.s. with its seat in Hradec Králové.
2. The term 'RUNMAGEDDON / GLADIATOR RACE' is used to promote sporting events.
3. The websites promoting sporting events are: www.runmageddon.pl, www.gladiatorrace.cz and social media profiles.
4. Participation in each sporting event is completely voluntary.
5. Active participation in any sporting event is possible - only after prior reading the content of these Regulations and its acceptance, setting up an account on the website www.runmageddon.pl or www.gladiatorrace.cz and expressing relevant consents, submission of appropriate statements and acceptance all conditions for participation.
6. Compliance with these Regulations by the Participant is mandatory.

II. THE AIM OF THE EVENT

Organising an sport competition aiming at both supporting and promoting physical activity which are a combination of:

1. Physical activity skills;
2. Competition but at the same time cooperation skills;
3. Physical effort and great fun.

III. ORGANIZER

All the events (including regular races and races for kids) are organized by Extreme Events sp. z o.o. with its seat in Warsaw (01-640), Jana Chryzostoma Paska 21 St., registered under KRS number 0000595982 with the share capital of 9,000 PLN and SPORTVISIO z.s. with its seat in Hradec Kralove, Stredbi 1724/9, entered into the register of entrepreneurs under No. IC 01227602, called later 'Organizers'.

IV. DESCRIPTION

RUNMAGEDDON / GLADIATOR RACE sports events are focused on good fun, to which the excuse is physical effort and competition for the title of "THE HARDEST PLAYER". There are obstacles along the route that verify the participants' agility, jumping ability, strength and mental resistance.

PARTICIPANT - is a person participating in a sporting event, after fulfilling all necessary formalities described in these Regulations and on the websites: www.runmageddon.pl or www.gladiatorrace.cz, as well as other conditions indicated by the Organizers.

Participation in sporting events RUNMAGEDDON / GLADIATOR RACE requires physical fitness, mental resilience and perseverance. Participation in RUNMAGEDDON / GLADIATOR RACE sporting events carries a known as well as unforeseen risk of physical injury and / or death, illness and / or destruction or loss of personal property. Participation in RUNMAGEDDON / GLADIATOR RACE sporting events is entirely voluntary and resulting from the free will of the Participant, who has to accept all risks and confirm that his participation in each of the Events is of his own free will and is completely voluntary, regardless from what was suggested to him in any way. The participant has the full right to choose and may at any time withdraw from participation, starting from the beginning of the race. The participant does not have to participate in any exercise, obstacle and may withdraw from participation at any time. The participant decides for himself whether his health, fitness or other conditions allow him to participate in the event or part of it.

V. RACE DATE AND VENUE

1. The events take place in the Czech Republic. The venue, time and all the details regarding the race are available on the Organizer's websites: www.runmageddon.com and www.gladiatorrace.cz, called later 'Websites'.
2. Only registered participants can take part in the race.
3. The organizers have the right to change the date and / or location of the race, whereby the Participant will be notified by posting relevant information on the Websites and by e-mail, no later than 24 hours before the start of the race, unless this proves impossible. Making changes does not result in additional obligations of the Organizers towards the Participant or any claims of the Participant against the Organizers.
4. The organizer reserves the right to cancel the race without giving reasons. In this case, the Participant is entitled, at his option, to sign up for another course or to request a refund of the paid entry fee. The Organizers will inform the Participants about the cancellation of the race by posting the relevant information on the Websites and in the form of an e-mail, providing details of the registration for another course or refund of the fees paid.

VI. OBSTACLES

Each race course has different number of obstacles which number and difficulty level depends on the type of the course the participant selected. Detailed information about the obstacles are on the Websites. There are 2 types of the obstacles:

- a) Natural, such as: marshes, ponds, lakes, rivers, sea, hills, mountains, trees;
- b) Artificial, such as Walls, ropes, horizontal crossings, obstacles from horse races, spider webs, gravel, water, mud or ice tanks.

VII. PARTICIPATION AND USE OF THE PARTICIPANT'S IMAGE

1. The competition is open for all persons who will be 18 years of age on the day of the event, except of the cases described in point 2 -4 below.
2. The right to start in races organized in the following formulas: Intro and Rekrut is also granted to participants who at the latest on the day of the start of the race are 16 years old, provided that they submit their consent to participate in the event signed by the Participant's legal guardian on the day of the start of the sport event in the competition office (personal presence in the competition office and confirmation of the guardian's identity with a photo document are mandatory). A template of consent is included in Appendix 2 to these Regulations.
3. The right to start in races held in formulas:
 - a) Kids - have minors who are at least 4 years old and no more than 12 years old on the day they start,
 - b) Junior - have minors who are at least 12 years old and no more than 16 years old on the day they start,

provided that on the day of the start of the sporting event in the competition office, permission to participate in the event is signed by the child's legal guardian (personal presence in the competition office and confirmation of the guardian's identity with a photo document is mandatory). A template of consent is included in Appendix 2 to these Regulations.

4. The right to start in Family formula is held by minors who are at least 4 years old and no more than 15 years old on the day of the start of the race, provided that on the day of the start of the sporting event in the competition office, permission to participate in the event signed by legal guardian of the child. In the event that the child's legal guardian entrusts the care of a minor to a third party during the run, the condition for the minor's participation in the event is the submission of a statement on consent and entrusting care signed by the legal guardian and the actual guardian making a statement in person in the competition office. A template of consent is included in Appendix 3 and 4 to these Regulations. Minors take part in the Family formula under the care of at least one adult.
5. In order to take place in the RUNMAGEDDON/ GLADIATOR RACE event it is required to:

- a) Create an account at www.runmageddon.pl or www.gladiatorrace.cz and fill out the application form;
 - b) Express consent to comply with these Regulations;
 - c) Accept of participation at your own risk, bearing in mind the dangers and risks arising from the nature and length of the race, which may include at risk of losing (deteriorating) health or life;
 - d) Express a separate consent to the processing of the Participant's personal data provided in the application form referred to above;
 - e) Express consent to the free use of the Participant's image recorded in the form of a photo or video in the media messages and promotional materials of the Organizers, on the principles described below in points 6-10.
6. The Participant grant the Organizers permission to use the Participant's image in the following cases:
- a) to reproduce in any form materials such as photographs, images, videotapes, recordings, motion pictures, or any other depiction of any kind of the Participant in an Event;
 - b) to share the materials or their copies with the sponsors in order to promote the sponsor's attendance in the event,
 - c) to store the materials on the Organizer's discs and computers,
 - d) to copy the materials,
 - e) to display the materials publicly in chosen by the Organizer place and time,
 - f) to publish the materials in the Press, on the Internet (including social media), posters and billboards,
 - g) to use the materials on TV and the radio,
 - h) to use the materials as photos from the race course.
7. Disseminating the image referred to in point 6 above is based on a permit. Permission is granted by the Participant by accepting these Regulations:
- a) When registering online for a specific race on the website www.runmageddon.pl or www.gladiatorrace.cz
 - b) During online acceptance of the statement on the website www.runmageddon.pl or www.gladiatorrace.cz
 - c) When signing the statement before the start.
8. The declaration of will referred to in p. 7 above - the permit - may not be freely withdrawn after being expressed when the Event has been completed.
9. The processing of the Participant's image does not violate the provisions of the GDPR and is carried out on the basis of art. 6 clause 1 lit. f) GDPR, according to which: "Processing is lawful when it is necessary for purposes arising from legitimate interests pursued by the controller or by a third party."
10. The list of official partners of the Organizers and sponsors who can publish the Participant's image is available on the Organizers' websites.
11. A model statement containing the consents referred to in para. 5 c-e, constitutes Appendix No. 1 to these Regulations.

VIII. REGISTRATION

1. The limit of participants is determined separately for each event.
2. The condition to sign up for the race is to set up an account on the website www.runmageddon.pl or www.gladiatorrace.cz, fill out the electronic form on one of these pages and pay the entry fee.
3. By registering for the race, the Participant indicates the date of start and the formula in which he will participate in the race; in addition, the Participant indicates his preferred time (series). The decision about the start time of a given Participant is taken by the Organizers, if possible taking into account the preferred time indicated by the Participant when registering. The organizers will inform the Participant about the start time at least 24 hours before the start of the first series in the formula chosen by the Participant as part of the event by posting this information on the website www.runmageddon.pl, www.gladiatorrace.cz or on the account registered by the Participant.
4. Registration for the race with a guarantee of receiving all benefits is accepted up to 7 days before the day on which the race will take place.

5. Submission at a later date is possible subject to the availability, however, the Organizers do not guarantee the completeness of the starter package to persons who will subscribe after the deadline referred to in p. 4 above.
6. Online registrations are closed 3 days before a given run. After this date, the Participant may register only in the race office.
7. A participant with a voucher or discount code may register for the race using this voucher or discount code no later than 5 days before the start of the race.
8. Only a team consisting of at least 2 and at most 5 people can participate in the Family formula; each team must include one adult and one minor.

IX. ENTRY FEE

1. The entry fees increase as the event date approaches; the fee is determined by the payment date, not the registration date.
2. The entry fee value for each race is published in the Prices section on the Websites.
3. The entry fee must be paid within 7 days from the registration date but not later than 3 days before the scheduled race date. The payment needs to be made by bank transfer to the bank account given at the registration process. The transfer title that has to be provided by the Participants will be generated by the registration system or the fast payment system while signing up for the race. After expiry of the above-mentioned time, the Organizers may transfer the unpaid registration to the last series of the race without notifying the Participant. As far as possible, Organizers will inform the Participant about the planned transfer for 3-5 days prior to the race by e-mail to the Participant's e-mail address provided at registration. It is also possible to pay the entry fee at the race office by cash or credit card, if the event is not full yet. Organizers are entitled to charge an administrative fee in this case.
4. A team discount is available for teams taking part in one race. The value of the discount is published on websites in the Prices section (as a rule team discount is applicable for races not shorter than Rekrut). Team discount is not applicable to those who have paid for the entry in the race office and not via online registration.
5. In order to collect a team discount for the event, one should use an individual code with discount amount for another Runmageddon event. Team discount cannot be joint with any other discounts and special offers, it also does not apply to the purchase of a package of several starts.
6. The entry fee cannot be assigned to other participant nor the data provided during registration cannot be changed after signing up and making the payment.
7. The entry fee is non-refundable. Each participant may purchase insurance against the costs of resignation from participation in the race. Such insurance offers, among others, cooperating with the Organizers – TU Europa S.A.

X. BENEFITS

Entry fee includes:

- a) participation in the race;
- b) starter kit (more information available on the sub-pages for particular events);
- c) a souvenir medal or other gift certifying the participation in the race (given only if the race was completed and all the obstacles were overcome);
- d) a drink;
- e) basic medical care;
- f) possibility to leave your belongings in the deposit (the terms of use of the deposit published on websites).

XI. SAFETY

1. Organisers will put all the efforts to ensure safety during the race. Basic medical care during the event will be ensured.

2. Due to the unique nature of the races, one must prepare for possible scratches, abrasions and injuries caused by attempts to pass the obstacles set on race track. The Participants are the only responsible for all the injuries that appeared during the race. The participants take part in the event on their own responsibility.
3. The Organizers reserve the right to stop the participants whom they decide to be in need of medical assistance, immediate warming up or any other form of help required.
4. Due to your own (and other participants) safety it is forbidden to compete in boots with spiked soles.
5. The Organizers reserve the right to deny the right to start to the Participants after alcohol and/or drugs consumption, being aggressive, having inappropriate outfit (e.g. boots with spiked soles) and/or to those who in any way threaten life and/or health of the other participants, the Organizers and their partners. The start fee is non-refundable in such case.

XII. PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION

1. Both Organizers are personal data controllers.
2. Personal data of the Participants will be co-processed by the Organizers in order to organize the event and award the competitors. Name, surname, year of birth and city of residence of the Participants will be used in order to publish the start list, the race results and general classification.
3. Personal data of the Participants will be processed by the Organizer according to generally applicable law.
4. The Participant has the right look in and to modify their personal details, correct and complete them.
5. It is not obligatory to provide personal data by the Participants, however it is impossible to take part in the race without providing them.

The above Rulebook is a translation from the original Polish version. In case of any discrepancies between the Polish and English version, the Polish version shall prevail.
