

## **Who is the administrator of your personal data?**

The administrator, i.e. the entity deciding how your personal data will be processed, is Extreme Events Limited Liability Company based in Warsaw (code: 01-640) at Jana Chryzostoma Paska 21 street, entered into the National Court Register under the number 0000535982 (hereinafter referred to as the "Company") - owner of the website [www.runmageddon.pl](http://www.runmageddon.pl) (hereinafter "Runmageddon"), and the Fundacja Runmageddon with its registered office in Warsaw (code: 01-640) at Jana Chryzostoma Paska 21 street, entered into the National Court Register under the number 0000540887 (hereinafter "the Foundation" and together as "We").

If you register for an event organized in the Czech Republic, Sportvisio z.s. based in Hradec Kralove in the Czech Republic (hereinafter referred to as "Sportvisio"), will be the co-administrator of your personal data. Sportvisio is a co-organizer of all events taking place in the Czech Republic.

## **Where do we get your personal data from?**

We received them from you when you created your account at [www.runmageddon.pl](http://www.runmageddon.pl), as well as when you provided us with a signed Statement at the event.

## **What is the purpose and legal basis for us to process your personal data?**

We process your personal data because:

- it enables us to contact you to inform you about the organization of sporting events in which you want to participate or take part;
- receiving from you the necessary statements and consents to participate in sporting events,
- inform you about all details related to the course of sporting events;
- it enables us to: inform you about sports results from sporting events organized by us; handling requests that you direct to us; contacting you, including for purposes related to our company;
- in addition, the law requires us to process your data for tax and accounting purposes.

We also process your personal data for the purposes set out below, based on a legitimate interest, which is:

- contacting you, including for purposes related to permitted marketing activities, through available communication channels,
- providing support for payment services;
- organization of loyalty programs, competitions and promotional campaigns in which you can participate;
- debt collection; conducting court, arbitration and mediation proceedings;
- conducting statistical analyzes;
- storing data for archiving purposes, and ensuring accountability (demonstrating our compliance with legal obligations).

If you agree, we process your personal data in order to:

- saving data in cookies, collecting data from websites and mobile applications;
- organization of competitions and promotional campaigns in which you can take part;

You can withdraw your consent to the processing of personal data at any time by sending such information to the e-mail address: [Montaż@runmageddon.pl](mailto:Montaż@runmageddon.pl). The update withdrawal process can take up to 72 hours. We will process your personal data until you withdraw your consent.

### **Do you have to provide us with your personal data?**

When setting up an account, we expect you to provide the following personal data: email address, password, date of birth, first name, last name, gender, clothing size, phone number, city, state, country, preferred currency, sports preferences.

If required by law, we may require you to provide other data necessary, e.g. for accounting or tax reasons. Apart from these cases, providing your data is voluntary.

### **What are your rights towards the Company regarding the data being processed?**

We guarantee compliance with all your rights arising from the General Data Protection Regulation [GDPR], i.e. the right to access, rectify and delete your data, limit their processing, the right to transfer them, not to be subject to automated decision making, including profiling, as well as the right to express object to the processing of your personal data.

You also have the right to lodge a complaint regarding the processing of your personal data by us to the supervisory body, which is the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection

You also have the right to object to the processing of your personal data.

### **Who do we share your personal data with?**

We share your personal data with entities supporting us in conducting business activities and organizing sporting events, i.e. those that support IT services, support the promotion of offers, cooperate in marketing campaigns, organization of events, sports associations, including OCR Poland.

How long do we store your personal data?

We store your personal data until you withdraw your consent and / or cancel your account on our platform [www.runmageddon.pl](http://www.runmageddon.pl), and also after its completion for the purposes of:

- pursuing claims,
- performance of obligations arising from legal provisions, in particular tax and accounting ones.

We store your personal data for marketing purposes until you object to such processing, depending on which of these events occurs earlier.

For accountability purposes, i.e. to prove compliance with the provisions on the processing of personal data, we will store data for the period in which the Company is obliged to keep data or documents containing them to document compliance with legal requirements and to enable control by public authorities.

### **Do we transfer your data to countries outside the European Economic Area?**

As a rule, we do not transfer your personal data outside the EEA. The transfer of personal data outside the EEA occurs only when you participate in Runmageddon Global (e.g. Sahara, Caucasus), which takes place outside the EEA. In such a situation, in order to provide the service, personal data is transferred to entities - contractors cooperating with Extreme Events, providing components of the booked tourist event, such as: hotels, airlines, pilots, guides, transport companies, local contractors providing the organization of a sightseeing program at a holiday destination. Personal data that is provided by Extreme Events is limited to the minimum necessary and only for the purpose of performing the contract. Accordingly, personal data may be transferred outside the European Economic Area, where,

as a rule, European rules do not apply. This means that the protection of personal data of European Union citizens may not be sufficient. For some of these countries, the European Commission has not found an adequate level of personal data protection, however, the transfer of data to a third country is necessary to perform the contract.

**Do we process your personal data automatically (including through profiling) in a way that affects your rights?**

Your personal data will be processed in an automated manner (including in the form of profiling), however, it will not have any legal effects on you or similarly significantly affect your situation. The profiling of personal data by the Company involves the processing of your data (also in an automated manner), by using it to evaluate certain information about you, in particular to analyze or forecast personal preferences and interests.

**Rules regarding the co-administration of your personal data**

Extreme Events and Sportvisio, as co-controllers of personal data of participants who signed up for events taking place in the Czech Republic, agreed on the principles of their liability in the scope of fulfilling the obligations arising from the provisions of the GDPR:

- 1) Extreme Events is responsible for fulfilling the information obligation towards you, which follows by providing you with the above information;
- 2) Extreme Events is responsible to you for contacting you in all matters related to your participation in the event as well as in all matters related to the processing of your personal data, which means that all queries, applications, complaints and other correspondence can be directed directly to Extreme Events, to the addresses indicated above. Notwithstanding the foregoing, you may also exercise your rights against Sportvisio. In this case, Sportvisio will forward your request to Extreme Events, which will process your request.
